Recently presented at an annual SOA meeting, Alycia Slyck will be speaking about her experiences working overseas as an actuary as well as her colleagues (from the International Section of the SOA) experiences. The possibilities are endless: working overseas remotely, living on location and short term assignments. There are a variety of reasons to consider casting a wider net, from the professional growth opportunities to the cultural diversity.

Before joining The Standard as Director and Assistant Actuary, Alycia worked as an actuary in Japan for nearly 6 years. While in Japan, she was responsible for financial reporting on Canadian GAAP and US GAAP basis, experience studies, minor pricing and Embedded Value reporting. Prior to moving her career overseas, she worked for a mutual insurer in Cincinnati, Ohio in pricing and valuation roles. She is an FSA and has held positions on the SOA International Section Council and the International Section of the Institute of Actuaries Japan (IAJ). While an International Section Council member, Alycia doubled the size of the SOA ambassador program, first as the regional coordinator for Europe, Middle East and Asia and later as the global coordinator of the ambassador program. She has also presented at SOA meetings and moderated SOA webcasts.
