Description:

Insurance carriers in Oregon have just completed filing their health plans for the 2015 calendar year, considered the second year of the Affordable Care Act (though technically, it will overlap the fifth and sixth years). We will look at the major cost drivers in health insurance, both before and after the ACA and how these drivers play a role over the next 2 years. We will also look at the specific role competition and regulation has played in Oregon, producing some of the lowest insurance rates in the country.

Speaker Bio:

Michael Sink is an ASA and has 15 years actuarial experience, including 8 years pricing Medicare and 4 years pricing commercial products. Currently he works for the Oregon Insurance Division reviewing commercial health insurance rates, and has spent the last 4 years focused on the pricing impact of the Affordable Care Act.
