Description:

Conflict is the natural tension that arises from differences. A conflict can be ignored or we can choose to resolve the conflict. When a conflict is ignored, it tends to escalate. Mediation is a powerful and effective process that often resolves conflicts in a positive and lasting way. The presentation will describe the process and techniques mediators use during mediation and that can be used in many settings where actuaries and others find themselves in conflict.
