The Casualty Actuarial Society recently celebrated its 100th year of existence and while much of the underlying work and defining principles of casualty actuarial work remain the same, there have been huge changes in the processes, technology and scope of the profession. Camille Minogue, a board member of the society with over 25 years of actuarial experience, will give an introduction to the newly-formed CAS Institute and provide an update on other CAS activities and future plans.

Camille is a fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society and an affiliate member of the Canadian Institute of Actuaries with over 25 years of actuarial experience. She has held positions as chief actuary in both the US and Canada, most recently as Insurance Corporation of BC, Canada's largest automobile insurance company. She is also an adjunct professor at Simon Fraser University in British Columbia, where she teaches a course in property and casualty insurance. Previous to her actuarial career, she earned a PhD in mathematics from Washington State University. Camille is currently on hiatus from her actuarial career in order to pursue her long-held desire to study law. She remains active with actuarial committees and education and serves on the CAS Board of Directors.
